## 1. The venue

The conference takes place at the Kostis Palamas Building of the University of Athens, located at:

**48 Akadimias Street & Sina Street, 105 62 Athens**

The building is situated on one of Athens' most elegant neoclassical avenues, just a short walk from Syntagma Square and within the upscale Kolonaki neighbourhood. The area is safe, walkable, and very well served by public transport.

## 2. Getting from the airport to the city

Athens International Airport "Eleftherios Venizelos" (ATH) is approximately 35 km southeast of the city centre. Four options are available:

Option	Cost	Time	Notes
<b>Metro — Line 3 (Blue)</b> Recommended	€9 one-way €16 return	~40 min	Direct to Syntagma. Contactless bank card accepted since Jan 2025.
<b>X95 Express Bus</b> Budget option	€5.50 one-way	60–90 min	Runs 24/7. Tickets at kiosk, Exits 4–5.
<b>Taxi / Ride-hailing</b> FREENOW, Uber, Bolt	€40 (day) €55 (night)	35–45 min	Flat rate, tolls included. Rank at Exit 3.
<b>Pre-booked Transfer</b> Best for groups	€50–70 per vehicle	35–45 min	Driver meets you at arrivals. Book online in advance.

*💡 A 3-day tourist pass (€20) covers a return airport trip plus unlimited travel on all Athens metro, bus, and tram lines — excellent value if you arrive a day before the conference or stay on afterwards. This is available at bus and metro ticket kiosks at Athens International Airport.*

### 3. Getting around Athens

The nearest metro station to the venue is Panepistimio (Line 2 — Red line), approximately a 5-minute walk along Akadimias Street. Syntagma station (Lines 2 & 3) is also within easy walking distance (~10 minutes) and is the main hub for connections across the city.

A standard metro/bus ticket costs ~€1.90 and is valid for 90 minutes across all modes (metro, bus, trolleybus, tram). You can buy tickets at station machines or simply tap a contactless bank card directly at the gates. The network is modern, air-conditioned, and reliable.

The central area — Syntagma, Kolonaki, Plaka, Monastiraki — is very walkable, and most hotels suggested below are within a 10–15 minute walk of the venue.

💡 *Taxis within the city are metered and affordable; most inner-city trips cost €5–12. The **FREENOW** and **Bolt** apps work well throughout Athens and offer cashless payment.*

### 4. Accommodation

We recommend booking in the Kolonaki, Syntagma, or Exarcheia neighbourhoods, all within easy walking distance of the venue.

#### Apartments & Airbnb

Kolonaki and the surrounding streets (Skoufa, Tsakalof, Solonos) offer a large supply of high-quality serviced apartments and Airbnb listings — ideal for longer stays or those who prefer more space. Search on Booking.com or Airbnb filtering by "Kolonaki" or "Syntagma".

💡 ***Book as early as possible.** Athens in July is peak tourist season and availability fills up fast. Prices rise significantly closer to the date.*

### 5. Athens in July — what to expect

- **Weather:** Hot and sunny. Daytime temperatures: 32–38 °C. Evenings are warm and pleasant (~24–27 °C). Carry water and sunscreen.
- **Currency:** Euro (€). ATMs are widely available. Cards accepted almost everywhere.
- **Language:** Greek, but English is very widely spoken in central Athens, hotels, and restaurants.
- **Food & dining:** Excellent tavernas and cafés throughout Kolonaki, Monastiraki, and Plaka. Many places stay open late — dinner often starts at 21:00.

- **Sightseeing:** The Acropolis, National Archaeological Museum, Benaki Museum, and Plaka are all within easy reach. Visiting the Acropolis before 09:00 is strongly advised in July to beat the heat and crowds.
  - **Safety:** Central Athens is safe. As in any major city, be mindful of pickpockets on busy metro lines and in crowded tourist areas.
  - **Pharmacies:** Easily found throughout the centre; many staff speak English.
